



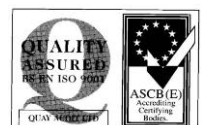

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## Terms and Conditions for ACCS Ltd Site Installation

1. Unless otherwise stated, the whole of the work detailed in this quote is to be carried out in a single continuous visit to the site. This will occur during normal working hours (typically 0800-1630 hrs. Monday - Friday), where adequate access to the working area is provided, and it is free from obstructions and other trades. Additional visits to site will be charged at £650 per visit.
2. All unfixed plant and equipment to be removed from the work area, any fixed items should be suitably protected, all pipe entries, pumps, valves or process equipment should be locked off or immobilised prior to the commencement of works.
3. The following attendances and services must be supplied and maintained on site adjacent to the work areas for ACCS Ltd by the client for the duration of the works, and where necessary for the cure period, free of charge and without interruption. In particular, an electrical power supply consisting of 110volt AC minimum 10kva using standard 3 pin 16amp, and where necessary 32amp sockets, must be made available. Mains or generator is acceptable.
  - a. Suitable artificial lighting to carry out proposed works. This should consist of overhead lighting, and where necessary additional lighting appropriate to the task.
  - b. Ventilation or extraction equipment suitable to the task.
  - c. Artificial heating may be required by some of the ACCS Ltd lining systems. This is especially important in cold weather or exposed conditions. This equipment must be suitable for purpose and should be agreed with ACCS Ltd staff prior to commencement on site. In general, working areas must be kept at a nominal temperature of 10 °C.
  - d. A supply of clean water must be made available adjacent to the work area.
  - e. All necessary access/egress equipment must be provided for adequate movement in and out of the work area. All scaffold structures must be inspected and maintained by competent staff and in accordance with current regulations. (Consult ACCS Ltd Staff if scaffold structures are to be used, as loading of such structures may be important.
  - f. All fixed plant, walkways, process or live working areas should be suitably de-marked, protected and screened prior to commencement of work by ACCS Ltd.
  - g. The work area, if exposed to the elements, must be covered with a fully waterproof cover for the duration of the works. All scaffold structures must be inspected and maintained by competent staff and in accordance with current regulations. Where cover cannot be provided or allowed, allowances must be made by the client for any adverse weather conditions which prevent ACCS Ltd staff from completing the works.





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- h. The client must prepare the work area beforehand (unless otherwise stated) to a finished standard, given in ACCS Ltd product information sheets. In addition thorough cleaning to remove any dust, oils or laitance. Failure to comply may result in defective application and/or effectiveness of ACCS Ltd products.
  - i. Initial offloading of materials by mechanical means should be provided by the client. ACCS Ltd materials are generally palletised and may weigh in excess of 500 kgs.
  - j. ACCS Ltd materials should be stored in a secure and covered space adjacent to work area or in close proximity to it. Storage temperature to be approx. 10-20 °C. For movement of palletised materials, client assistance is required. On sites where the work area is above ground level suitable lifting or hoisting equipment must be maintained for the duration of the works and if no operator is available, suitable training given to ACCS Ltd staff for proper use of lifting machinery.
  - k. Welfare, canteen, access to washing and changing facilities must be provided for ACCS Ltd staff. First aid and adequate site safety cover must be provided for the duration of the contract and within standard working hours.
  - l. ACCS Ltd will remove all empty drums and waste products as soon as possible after completion of the contract and will be disposed of in accordance with current national legislation. Suitable lay-down areas should be provided by the client for the safe storage and provision for loading of these waste materials. Any waste material arising from the preparation of the work area by the client, or due to additional site preparation by ACCS Ltd staff, must be disposed of by the client.
4. ACCS Ltd reserve the right to recover costs for any lost time in accordance with our schedule of day work rates, for any delay due to the above attendances not being provided. If necessary ACCS Ltd will also provide any necessary further services and charge them in accordance with our schedule of day work rates.
